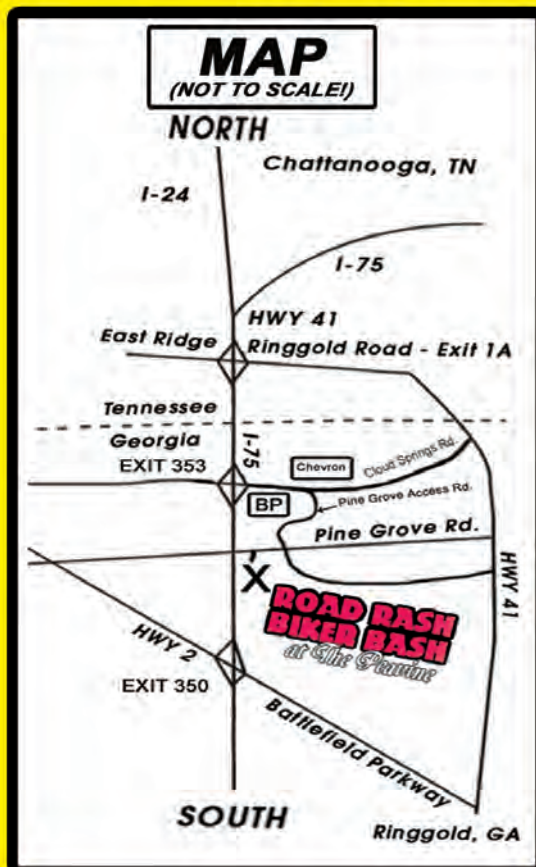

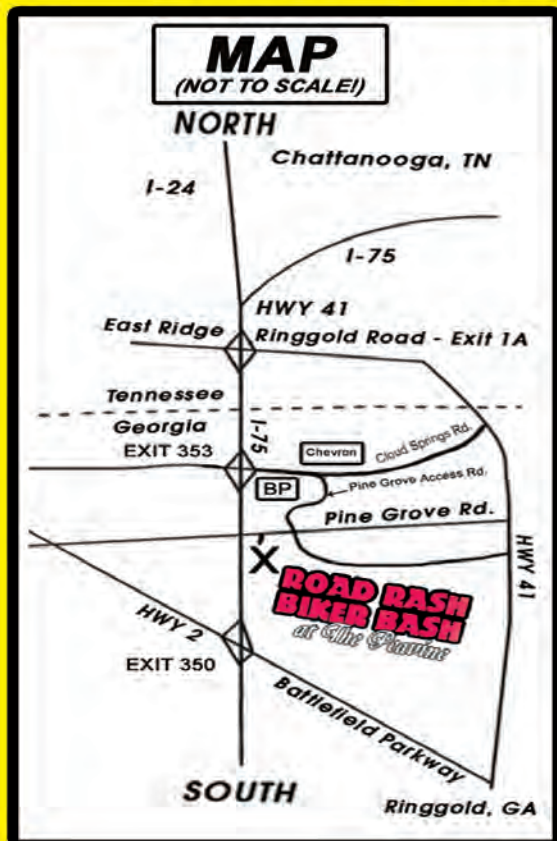

best. In addition to the vents in front and back, it has gusseted shoulders, and extra long sleeves. The sleeves are removable, making it a fully zipping vest. I use it that way more than with the sleeves. My boots and gloves are by HD.

My skin crawls when I see what a lot of today's inexperienced and "newbie" riders wear. Education can come to riders in various forms. Education can come through simply using common sense, watching older experienced riders, or through the school of hard knocks.

Those who wouldn't mind hopping around on a fake foot or two wear tennis shoes. If I had been wearing tennis shoes a few years ago when Julie and I went down, I wouldn't have a right foot today. When the only thing between you and the pavement is your feet you better protect them! *Tennis shoes are for games, not motorcycles.*

The same holds true for boat shoes, a favorite of many "Wingers." *Boat shoes are for the "Love Boat," not motorcycles.*

Then we have our short pants riders. Now it takes a *special* kind of idiot to wear shorts on a motorcycle. Have you ever just barely touched your leg to a hot exhaust pipe with shorts on? Try it some time. A micro second touch is a painful, scarring, touch. Now imagine that you scoot is sliding down the road on it's side with your body under it and your bare leg is trapped under the exhaust. HELLO! I've heard people say, "What difference could that little bit of denim make?" It

makes a lot of difference. Don't take my word for it, just try both and let me know what you find out. *Shorts are for anything you want except motorcycles.*



Joe Cool's Biker Health



The hot summer months are upon us. With beautiful sunny days comes great days on the open roads. And many of these days will be very hot. You need to hydrate as often as possible. Not just beer mind you, but H₂O, which as we all know is water. Water is a simple chemical compound of two parts hydrogen and one part oxygen. This simple compound is the most important element on earth. No living creature that I am aware of can exist without it. But, the funny thing is, most people do not drink enough of it.

Water makes up 47 to 75 percent of our body weight, but please do not think you should starve yourself of water to lose weight. Proper hydration and water consumption can actually help you loose weight. Water aids in the metabolic breakdown of nutrients needed for cellular energy and increases metabolism, burning fat calories faster. If you drink an eight-ounce glass of water before a meal, it will help suppress your appetite. Have water during meals instead of soft drinks. It has zero calories and it helps food digest more efficiently. In fact, water is essential in proper digestion and absorption of nutrients. Without it you would be weak, anemic and constipated, and that's no way to go through life. Water also helps maintain homeostasis of your metabolic system. In other

words, it helps keep you in balance. It is an essential component of blood pressure control. Water helps lubricate your joints, which diminishes the instances of arthritic conditions. It keeps your skin moist and fresh looking, therefore fewer wrinkles. It is essential in vitamin absorption, plasma development and electrolyte control.

The most important role that water plays in the human body is temperature control. It is used to maintain the core temperature, which usually is 89.6 degrees. It does this by absorbing heat from the body and releasing it through the skin, which, in turn, cools the skin during dehydration of the skin surface. Water will protect the vital organs and most specifically the brain. If you are dehydrated, the body will pull water from other less important areas to maintain the core temperature, therefore affecting the balance of the rest of your system.

Water is the only fluid the body needs to sustain life. It does not need sodas, Kool-Aid, tea, coffee, beer or wine. These fluids simply give your pleasure senses satisfaction. But, they are all right in moderation. Make sure that you consume at least 60 to 80 ounces of water or more a day. During hot summer days and extra activity days try to drink up to 100 ounces. Make water consumption, bottle or tap, a regular part of your dietary habit. So be cool and stay cool by drinking water, and I'll see you on the road.

Whistle Stop Café

There is a little town north of Macon, Ga that is the setting of the movie Fried Green Tomatoes. Juliette, Ga has become a favorite place for bikers to ride to on a Sunday afternoon to eat dinner. I have been hearing about bikers riding to this small community for the last two or three years. I thought it was time that I rode down to check this café out for myself and eat some fried green tomatoes and B.B.Q. This café is only open on the Sunday for people to come and eat.

I rode about sixty miles to Juliette, Ga and I turned off Hwy. 87 onto Juliette Rd. and made a right turn onto McCrackin St. Down at the end of town on the left side of the street set the Whistle Stop Café. It was just like stepping into the movie and you could almost see the characters coming down the street. The trains still run along the side the Ocmulgee River, but the old train engines have long gone.

I don't understand what draws bikers to ride to this small town except for the food and the awesome ride through the countryside. Bikers also walk around the town and visit small shops after their meal. Some have pictures taken at certain points that they remembered from the movie.

You can find on any given Sunday bikers from Atlanta to Augusta, Ga. or as far south as Waycross, Ga riding their bikes into town. It is one of the places in the state you can meet riders from all over the state of Georgia. I have counted more than one hundred bikes coming in town during the time I was having my meal. H.O.G. groups from all over the state call the café and makes reservations for thirty or more riders to eat.

Jarrell Plantation near Juliette, Ga is another place I like to visit during the afternoon. It is just a ten-mile or less ride to this Georgia plantation. It is a step back into the 1850's. The Plantation once covered 1000 acres

with a sawmill, gristmill, cotton gin and a shingle mill. Now it is a state park for everyone to visit and to look back into the past.

This is one of the trips I like to take at least once or twice a year for the fried green tomatoes and the scenic ride through the national forest. If you are ever riding your bike in the Macon, Ga. area on a Sunday afternoon, stop by the Whistle Stop Café. I hope to take your picture next time.

to sources I have the within the city, the system will be set up to catch the flagrant violators, not the borderline violators. Hopefully these efforts by our local government will be as successful as other communities using similar systems in getting a handle on this problem.

He was Nathan Hale and he was hanged without trial by order of British Major William Cunningham for spying on behalf of the Colonists against the British army intent on crushing the less powerful Colonies.

That is the nature of the spy; they are hated by one side while being greatly cherished by the other for risking their life for the cause, whatever that may be. 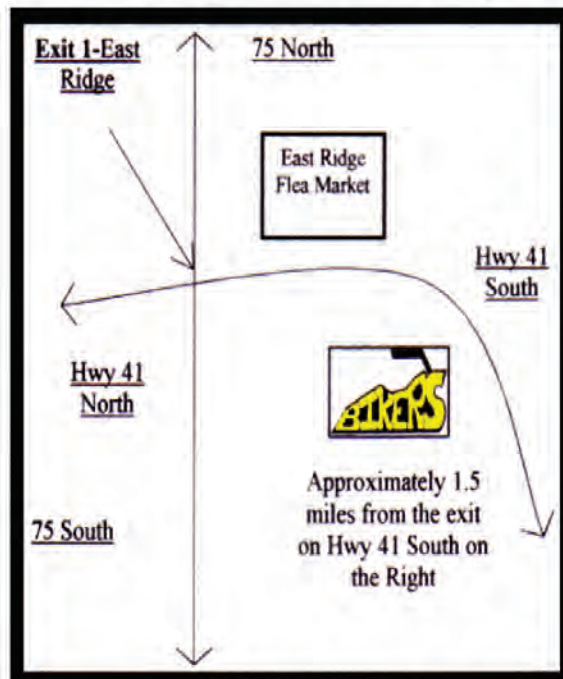

Dialog with "Diamond Dave"

Ring..ding.ding ding.ring.ding.ding.ding,.. That used to be a sound you heard on the street, as well as the track. What sort of animal made this kind of noise? The infamous two-stroke motorcycle, or "stokers," as we fans call them. Yes, before global warming, melting polar ice caps, and the EPA, us gearheads had stokers. A time when the sweet smell of unburnt hydrocarbons, could be seen, as well as smelled!


Some would not lament this passing, but as for me I miss the little, and big smokers. True, that today's four-stroke motorcycles are cleaner, faster, and more reliable. But, there is something special about disappearing away from a spotlight in a cloud of blue smoke. Two-strokes or two-cycle engines are light, simple and inexpensive to produce. They develop more usable power in every crankshaft revolution, and have fewer moving parts. Because of these attributes the two-stroke was perfect for light, cheap motorcycles, and scooters. Even a few Automobiles used this powerplant. Have you ever seen a pre-'68 Saab? Most motorcycle manufacturers used these engines in their smaller bikes. Harley had the Hummer, Pacer, and later offerings from Aermacchi. BSA, had the Bantam, Ariel had the Arrow. Of course most of my two-stroke street experiences came from Japanese machines.

With the so-called Japanese invasion in the USA in the sixties, came two-strokes from all the major manufacturers with the exception of Honda. Honda produced neat, clean,

and unbreakable four-strokes. Great bikes, but they did not hold the allure for me that the two-stroke marques had. Bridgestone had their Hurricane 175 twin, and the GTR 350, both of which are of rotary valve design. The GTR was also one of the first production machines to have a six-speed transmission! Kawasaki had two quick rotary valve twins in the A1, and the A7. These were predecessors to the legendary Tri-stars, or Triples. Produced in 250, 350, 400, 500, and 750cc displacements they made a believer out of many who thought camshafts and poppet valves were the only way to produce horsepower! Suzuki produced many a fine two-stroke bike. Most of these were 150cc or below until the introduction of the X6. The X6 Hustler was one of those quarter-liter machines that could humble bikes with more than twice its displacement. Suzuki would later produce a 500 twin, 380, 550, and 750 triples, all of which would run with the big boys. Yamaha had its entire racing championships based in two-stroke design. The Catalina, Big Bear, SC3, RC, RD, and RZ's all benefited from the tuning fork company's success with the TZ250, and mighty TZ750 two-stroke racers.

If this litany of stokers has sparked your curiosity in things that go ring..ding then I have a suggestion. May 10, thru May 13 at Deals Gap is the annual Two-Stroke Club meeting. Stokers of all sizes, and makes will be in attendance. Interested? Give us a call at Chattanooga Motorcycles - we are trying to organize a ride to the event



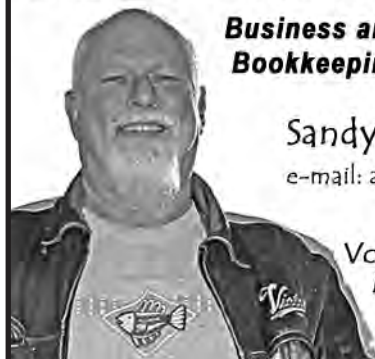

T.D.O.T. -

Totally Devoid of Thought

If you've never ridden a motorcycle on one of Tennessee's byways, then you don't know what you're missing. Whether it's being wobbled by the rain grooves on I-75, attempting to fathom state highway signs downtown or simply getting the word out that motorcycles really are allowed to treat regulated intersections as a four-way stops and proceed through an unchanging red light, the Tennessee Department of Transportation could stand some remedial education.

Let's see if I understand their mission statement: to provide a safe motoring surface, to plainly designate citizen funded thoroughfares, and plan construction and road repair in such a way that it doesn't bottleneck an entire city 24/7/365. Was it so long ago when the citizens of Chattanooga were held hostage with the Olgiate Bridge widening, the 24/75 downtown spruce up, the ridge-cut construction, the Eastgate I-75 interchange redesign, Highway 153 widening, I-75 widening at Hamilton Place...all at the same time?

Has been so long since the widening and repaving of Highway 153 that no one remembers how the construction company decided to "erase" the white lines that separate lanes of travel with the use of a grinding machine that left 4-inch by 5-foot by 3-inch deep divots the exact size of the line itself? If you were a motorcyclist, changing lanes was like playing Russian roulette. Perhaps the Department of Transportation should be financially responsible for the untold suspension alignments required by this brilliance.

Need a more recent tragedy? It may now be easier for northbound East Brainerd road to get onto Highway 153, but TDOT's interchange design places that same traffic in peril crossing over the highway to travel north on I-75. How many millions of dollars did we spend on this Rube Goldberg traffic travesty?

How many times were you stuck behind one of TDOT's famous "rolling roadblocks" while the Lee Highway exit along I-75 was being com-

pleted? When is TDOT going to learn the same thing other states learned 35 years ago: that it is cheaper, faster and safer to do major road construction at night during lighter traffic loads. And even if it weren't less expensive, it must be cheaper for a construction company like Britton Bridge to pay a nighttime labor surcharge than paying two years penalty on overdue construction. And will someone, please, tell TDOT that rain grooves are supposed to be cut across the path of travel so rain can actually drain off the highway.

Tennessee has one of the nation's highest taxes on gasoline (without a state income tax, roads projects must to be funded somehow). At one point, there were billions (with a "b") in the TDOT kitty. It's hard to believe that this kind of economic clout can foster such sophomoric road planning and construction. And talk about a silken parachute... their pact with the Tennessee legislature mandates that excess road construction funds cannot be used for anything other than road construction. Not lower gas taxes, not homeless shelters, not even country club memberships for the porkers that put this deal in place. Sweet!

Let's try this: all TDOT construction inspectors are now required to test road construction and repair on a motorcycle. Just because a cursory pass inside a beefed-up Suburban meets an inspector's personal criteria for a job-well-done, doesn't mean their official okey dokey passes the biker test... not by a long shot.

I'm totally in favor of progress. But if "pro" is the opposite of "con", until the Tennessee legislature reins in the autonomy of their beloved transportation golden goose, the opposite of progress will continue to be congress.

CMT/ABATE NEWS



Spring is here and that means the riding season is starting with earnest and the legislation process in Nashville is in full swing with CMT there protecting your right to ride.

This year CMT/ABATE has been able to have two different bills killed that would have made it illegal for kids 9 years old and under to ride on YOUR bike! Senator Finney introduced SB 2468 that would of prohibited 10 year olds and under, and Senator Harper SB 3032 and Representative Nathan Vaughn HB 3311 introduced similar bills that would of prohibited 9 year olds and under from riding on the back of your motorcycle.

CMT working with members of the Transportation committee pointed out that NHTSA statistics show NO fatalities in this category since 1994.

While any death particularly one of a child is tragic there is no trend that indicated that there was a need to make legislation to protect children from ourselves. Legislators were able to see the decision to let your child or grandkid ride should be one the parent should make not the State.

We continue to make progress on the Right of Way Violations Bill.

This bill sponsored by Senator Southernland SB 3696 and Representative Tidwell HB3431.

At the present time in Tennessee if a person maims or kills you because they ran a stop sign or red light they are only ticketed for running the stop sign or red light. Average fine in Tennessee around \$45.00.

The legislation above being written will make it illegal to run you over with fines and possible suspension of license.

Helmet Modification Bill

Senate bill SB 0807 and House bill HB 0456

Ah yes the big one we have all been waiting 30 years for!

At the time of this writing the bill is set to be heard in the Sub-Finance & Ways Committee April 12th.

The passing of this bill all hinges on its finance note. Legislators on this committee don't care about freedom they only care about the money.

This bill has a negative financial note.

It says that if motorcyclists are given a choice about wearing a helmet the State will lose money on those who could sustain a head injury because they were not wearing a helmet.

CMT is working and educating committee members showing the State stands to make more money on registration and sales taxes with the increase sales of motorcycles, accessories and an increase in tourism dollars than they ever pay out in Medicaid.

I encourage you to contact your State Representative and Senator and ask for their support on these bills. You can look up their numbers at www.legislature.state.tn.us

Our Tennessee Valley Charter of CMT/ABATE continues to grow as riders are now seeing that CMT is becoming an effective political force in Nashville.

J.B. Walker and the Cheap Whiskey Band is an Atlanta, Ga. based band. This long time biker band started back in 1985, which means they will celebrate their 20th anniversary in 2006.

I have been listing to J.B.'s music for last five or six years. I have always liked to work the rallies or bike shows where he is appearing. For me this is one of the must see bands on my list. **David Allan Coe** is another singer I like to hear. I always thought D.A.C. music had a great influence on J.B.'s work. You can hear this band playing Coe's songs at all their concerts. I am finding out more about these two singers. Their history of playing and singing together goes back a long time. You can always catch a show with J.B. at least once year playing with David Allan Coe somewhere in state of Georgia.

J.B. Walker, the lead singer, was born in Atlanta in November of 1957 and now lives in Mableton, Georgia. J.B. is a graduate of South Cobb High in Cobb County, Ga. He is an ex-corporate executive with a food chain store. He left the corporate world and set off on a great music career. J.B. Walker (Big Daddy) is now a world-renowned musician. His favorite entertainers are David Allan Coe and **Bruce Springsteen**. Every Daytona Bike week David and J.B. play together at the Iron Horse Saloon. The Cheap Whiskey Band has three other band members. The bass guitarist is **Robert Bruno**, also known as Dark Cloud. His last known address was in Villa Rica, GA. Robert began to play bass with The Cheap Whiskey back in 1989. He was born in Munich,

Germany. He attended high school in Dennison, Texas. He is also a Vietnam vet. and served in the Air Force. **Patrick Shumake** is the lead guitarist for the band. He was born in March of 1964 in Americus, Georgia. Patrick was named one of the World's Greatest Guitar Players by *Brother Magazine* in 1995. **Tim Dean** is the new drummer and has been playing with the band for the last few months. Two of the founding members are still with the band. This famous biker band is a group of talented musicians. Their music is appropriate for the bike rallies and stock car races where they are familiar sight. They are well known in Daytona Beach Fla. and at the Iron Horse Saloon. Where you find bikers, you will find this band playing.

Terrance Daniel is the band's manager. Terrance is kept busy doing bookings and looking for new venues for the band to play. He is a former United States Marine, biker and longtime business associate of the band.

The Cheap Whiskey Band over the years has made some great albums like *Pour the First Shot*, *Iron Horses*, *Harleys IN Heaven*, *Iron Horses And Wild Women 97* and *Over 40 And Half Naked*. Whether they are playing their original music or others, they will entertain you all night long with their brand of music.

Every year the band is called upon to help to entertain the bikers that come to the Ride To Save Babies in Atlanta, Ga. at Lakewood Exhibition. The Peachtree Thunder Parade through Downtown Atlanta and Buckhead starts at 1 p.m. Last year, nearly 3,000 riders helped to raise more than \$274,000 for newborn screening programs in the state of Georgia. You can find the band members up in the V.I.P. section ready for the trip to Buckhead and back. October 1, J.B. is scheduled to play from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. The March of Dimes can count on The Cheap Whiskey Band to provide their talent on ride day.

Last October at the Milledgeville Thunder Rally I had the chance to talk with J.B. Walker backstage about his music. The most exciting time for me at the rally is when I got to go on stage with J.B. Walker and take pictures up close. He later told me that he brought a little of home to the guys and gals in the armed forces. The biker-rock band has been playing for military audiences since Operation Desert Shield. J.B. and his band have been to Iraq twice to play for the soldiers and sailors. In 1999, J.B. and The Cheap Whiskey Band entertained U.S. troops for the seventh time as they rocked through the Balkans. In 1993 on the ship **USS Denver** (LPD-9) while off the coast of Somalia, they came aboard and played for the crew. The soldiers and sailors thought this was an awesome band everywhere they performed.

I don't understand why someone would go to a war zone to entertain the troops and put their life in danger. I believe it has to do with their patriotism. I know how it is to be in the Navy and away from home. Just to hear some music or see someone from the states will take you home for a couple of hours. This is a great southern rock band that plays through the South and 28 states. Also, the band has played in 32 counties around the world.

In my opinion, J.B. and The Cheap Whiskey Band is one of the hottest biker bands in the world. One of the things about attending J.B. Walker concerts is the wide variety of music that the band plays. Walkers' music is for and about the American biker with songs of rebellion, whiskey and women. If you enjoy listing to country music, biker or rock motor music is the band for you. With songs from David Allen Coe to the **Rolling Stones** their music is about what people care about. You will be jumping at your table or dancing on the dance floor to his music. 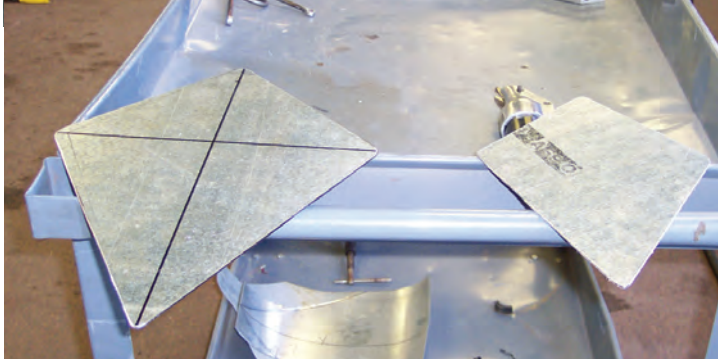
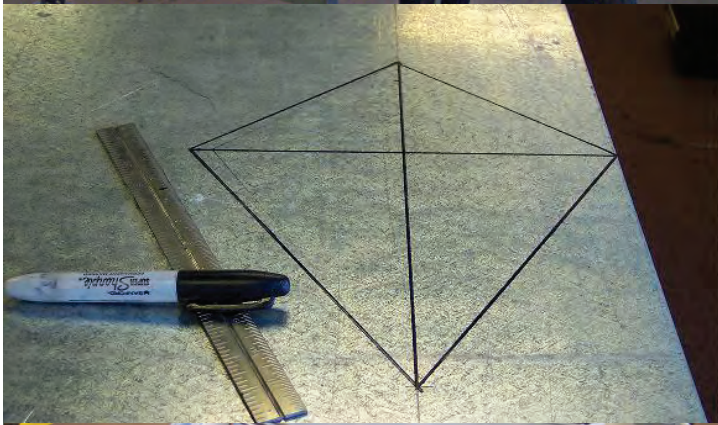
Making the Pan!
